FINDING THE DIAMONDS IN THE “RUFF”

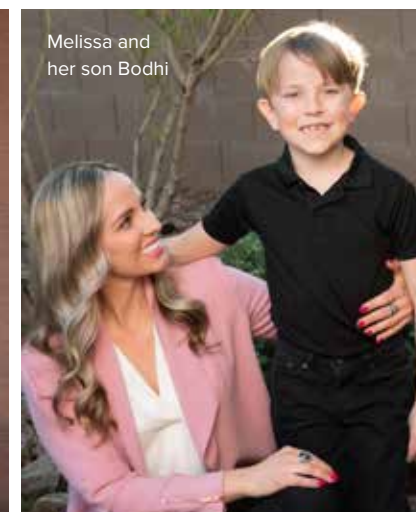
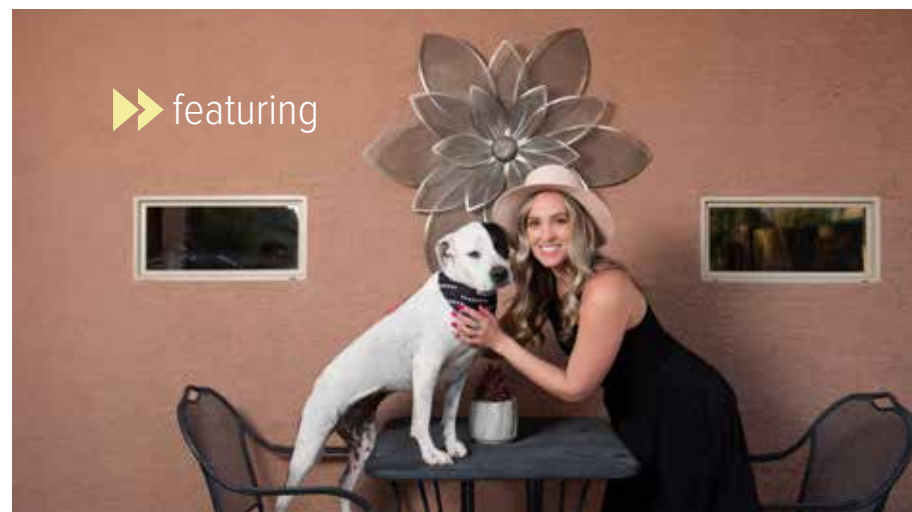


