

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

NAVIGATING THE NEW YORK STATE PROPERTY CONDITION DISCLOSURE STATEMENT:

WHAT REALTORS NEED TO KNOW

In a move aimed at bolstering transparency and protecting consumers, New York State has implemented a mandatory Property Condition Disclosure Statement for residential real estate transactions. This requirement underscores the state's commitment to ensuring that buyers have access to comprehensive information about the condition of properties they are considering purchasing. For realtors operating in New York State, understanding the intricacies of this new requirement is paramount. In this article, we'll explore the key components of the Property Condition Disclosure Statement and its implications for real estate professionals.

WHAT IS THE PROPERTY CONDITION DISCLOSURE STATEMENT?

The Property Condition Disclosure Statement is a standardized form that sellers must complete and provide to prospective buyers during residential real estate transactions in New York State. It is designed to disclose known material defects and other pertinent information about the property's condition, helping buyers make informed decisions about their purchase.

Real Producers: Does your pet have any tricks or funny habits?


Jillian: No really funny tricks or habits, but as a five-year-old dog, he's never been swimming. We are hoping to break that cycle this summer.

Real Producers: Does your pet's name have any significant meaning to you?


Leah: He runs like a racehorse - fast like a Ferrari (Enzo Ferrari).




