

Utilizing a **Power of Attorney** in a **REAL ESTATE** TRANSACTION

If you are a realtor assisting a client with the sale or purchase of property, but they cannot sign documents during the transaction due to inaccessibility or incapacitation, a Power of Attorney can be a helpful legal tool for closing the deal.

A Power of Attorney is a document that allows a person (the "principal") to grant one (or more) persons the authority to act on their behalf (the "agent"). A POA can be limited to a

specific action, such as the purchase or sale of real estate, or contain a broad range of general powers.

If a POA is going to be used on a real estate transaction, be sure to send a copy of the document to the closing attorney to review early on so they can ensure all requirements are met - that the document has been properly executed and notarized, and that it has the requisite language included that will permit the agent to







Q&A with **Loretta Grace**


Real Producers:
