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















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Hello November, the Season of Gratitude!

We're thrilled to announce our 2025 event schedule will be released soon! Stay tuned for more details—there will be fantastic opportunities to connect, learn, and grow together.




"We have a lot of traditions," Carlo explains. "It keeps us all together and gives us a chance to see each other."



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# Happy Smiles Foundation: Spreading Kindness, One Act at a Time

Happy Smiles Foundation: Spreading Kindness, One Act at a Time

The Happy Smiles Foundation operates on the belief that a single kind word or gesture has the power to transform not just a person's day but potentially their entire life. Driven by this mission, the organization dedicates itself to spreading kindness and positivity within the community. With the support of a passionate team of volunteers and board members who embody compassion and service, Happy Smiles leads initiatives ranging from anti-bullying campaigns in schools to creative community drives. Through these meaningful programs, the foundation remains committed to making a lasting, positive impact.

# Programs that Uplift and Inspire

They collaborate with public figures and community partners to create programs that unite people through kindness. This year, they started their Hope Totes Drive, which gathers comfort items for breast cancer patients undergoing chemotherapy in collaboration with Womens Council of Realtors Mercer, Weichert Realtors-Princeton Junction, and the YWCA Princeton Breast Cancer Resource Center. Also, one of their key initiatives, the Anti-Bullying Campaign, has featured prominent figures such as Darryl McDaniels (DMC) of RUN DMC, reaching children across various age groups to emphasize the importance of respect and empathy. Additionally, their Dr. Seuss Book Drive gathers books for children in underserved communities. Last year alone, over 1,000 books were collected and distributed to organizations such as the YWCA of Princeton, Millhill Child and Family Development, and the Miracle League of Mercer.

The foundation's annual **Thanksgiving Food Drive** helps families in need by providing complete Thanksgiving dinners in partnership with Grant Chapel AME Church and the Trenton Area Soup Kitchen (TASK). With over two tons of food collected, Happy Smiles ensures that everyone has access to a nourishing holiday meal. In addition to their Thanksgiving outreach, the Happy Smiles Foundation runs an ambitious **Holiday Toy Drive** aimed at collecting 1,000 new, unwrapped gifts to benefit children in need. The foundation encourages both local and distant supporters to donate, with options for dropping off items or donating via an Amazon wishlist. Local businesses can request donation boxes



and help spread awareness by tagging the foundation (@ happysmilesinc) on social media. Donors are encouraged to email Happy Smiles to anyone who wants to coordinate pickups (within 15 miles of 08691), drop-offs, or recommend families in need.

Beyond its Thanksgiving

efforts, the foundation extends its charitable outreach with two additional cornerstone initiatives—the Back-to-School Drive and the Hope Tots Drive. Happy Smiles partners with local businesses to host collection boxes for the Back-to-School Drive, gathering essential school supplies like backpacks, notebooks, pens, pencils, and calculators. They partnered with Vitale Inspections and invited participants to contribute school supplies during a special event featuring a breakout session on "Avoiding the Aggravations of Home Inspections." Attendees brought donations or used the foundation's Amazon wishlist to support local students. The goal is to ensure that children from underserved families start the academic year equipped and confident, leveling the playing field and giving every student the tools they need to succeed. On the other hand, the Hope Totes Drive gathers comfort items for breast cancer patients undergoing chemotherapy in collaboration with the Women's Council of Realtors Mercer, Weichert Realtors-Princeton Junction, and the YWCA Princeton Breast Cancer Resource Center.

Happy Smiles Foundation maintains a diverse range of programs and events aimed at making a tangible difference in the community. By allocating a portion of their revenue, Vitale

# Community Events with Purpose

Happy Smiles Foundation holds events that foster community connection and raise funds for vital causes. They hold an annual golf outing at Mountainview Golf Club to raise funds for the YWCA BCRC, which supports both men and women going through breast cancer, from consultation to beyond care, by providing free and discrete programs and services.

This year, the Happy Smiles Foundation hosted its inaugural major fundraising event, Wonka's Wonderland, honoring community partner Dan Sczweck from the Miracle League of Mercer County. This sweetest event raised funds through generous sponsors and Golden Ticket sales, which included food, an open bar with specialty drinks, interactive entertainment by magician and mentalist Matthew Swanson, and special appearances by the Oompa Loompas! Proceeds from the event benefit the Happy Smiles Foundation's community partners. Additionally, the event celebrated their collaborative efforts and included the "Pitch-In: A Catch with the Commish" event, which aims to raise funds for the Miracle League.
